



BOA SAN ANTONIO SUPER REGIONAL Marching Contest OVERNIGHT TRIP November 1st-2nd, 2019 - FINAL

The BOA San Antonio Super Regional is the most competitive marching contest in the country. 84 bands competing over two days, with the top 14 performing Saturday night in finals competition. There are bands competing from Texas, Ohio, Oklahoma, and California.

November 1st - Friday

4:00 am – Report time @ Keller High School for luggage check and information - Eat breakfast before you arrive and bring a snack with you on the bus ride to SA. Have your Grey Indian Spirit Shirt, athletic shorts, black socks and band shoes on. Hair is show-ready. Have a full water jug for the day. Bring a pillow and blanket with you on the charter bus.

5:00 am - Leave Keller High School for San Antonio - When you load the charter buses have your duffle bag, hanging bag and hat box under the bus.

10:00 am - Arrive at New Braunfels Buc-ee's - Eat early lunch and change into uniform

11:30 am - Leave Buc-ee's

12:00 pm – Arrive at the San Antonio Alamodome.

1:40-2:25 – Indoor Warmup

2:35 pm - Gate

2:45 pm – Prelims Performance

After Prelims Performance - Full Band group photo, section photos, individual photos, etc.

5:00 pm –Load truck, and your instrument goes under the charter buses. We will travel the short distance to our hotel to change clothes.

5:30 pm - Arrive at *Holiday Inn - San Antonio Downtown Market Square* - You will have enough time to change clothes (casual and no band shirt needed), quickly freshen up, and then head back to the buses.

6:00 pm - Leave for the Incredible Pizza Company

6:30 pm - Arrive at Incredible Pizza Co. To balance out the evening for their staff you will either 1] eat pizza buffet/play games OR 2] play games/eat pizza buffet. Always a fun time!
This meal will be provided for you-Bring spending money for games.

10:00 pm - Leave Incredible Pizza for hotel

10:30 pm - Everyone into rooms for evening

8:00 am - Check out of rooms, load equipment and luggage on the bus.

8:45 am - Leave for rehearsal

9:30 am - Arrive at rehearsal location - Taft High School

10:00 am-11:30 am - rehearse

11:30 am - Eat lunch(provided) in parking lot/ Change into Navy Fearless shirt, shorts, band shoes and socks on rehearsal site. Hair needs to be show ready when we leave rehearsal site for Alamdome.

1:00 pm - Load Buses

1:15 pm - Leave rehearsal site

2:00 pm - Arrive Alamodome - Equipment and uniform stays on bus.We will sit in the stands together for Prelims Announcements.

3:45 pm - Drum Majors on field for Prelims announcements.

Our schedule for the evening will be determined by our placement after prelims. Dinner will be provided for you this evening.

Wear Navy Fearless Shirt for finals

TBA – Finals performance - After the last group performs, BOA we will have a full band retreat, where all band students go onto the field for the announcement of the results. We will quickly change out of uniform after finals.

We will be back to Keller High School appx. 4:30 am-5:00 am. This arrival time takes into account “moving clocks back” for Daylight Saving Time adjustment.
